Every spring season (March and April), we welcome hungry visitors, along with other adepts of gluttony, and invite them to enjoy our authentic old-style meals.

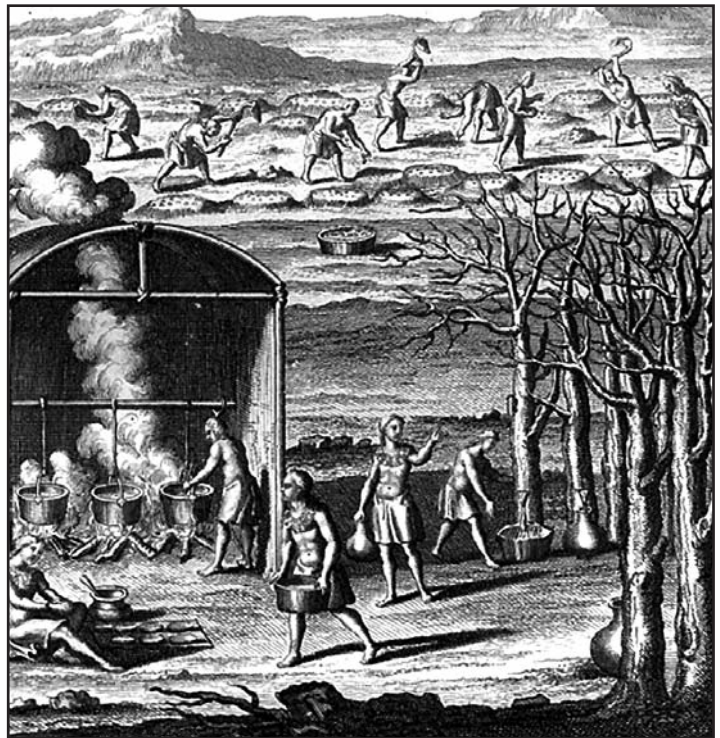
Beware: you'll be under the charm of our terrific historic characters & musicians.
